

NEW HEALTH REQUIREMENT
2015-2016 School Year

**Seniors must show proof of two doses of meningococcal vaccine
BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL IN AUGUST 2015
THE SECOND MENINGOCCAL SHOT MUST BE AFTER AGE 16
IF THE FIRST SHOT was given AFTER AGE 16,
then only 1 SHOT is needed for 12th grade.**

**Please do bring your shot record to the high school during registration or
before!!**

Welcome to Rantoul Township High School! Students who are attending Rantoul Township High School for the first time should be aware of the Illinois Requirements for Health.

If you attending a school in Illinois for the first time, you must submit the following documentation within 30 days of registration.

1. A Physical Exam – within the last calendar year, that includes the same requirements as the State of Illinois form, or a new physical recorded on the State of Illinois form must be submitted.
2. A Vision Exam – Illinois requires that students submit a vision exam from a licensed optometrist or ophthalmologist by October 15 of the school year, or must have an appointment for an exam.
3. Record of Immunizations – Proof of complete and up to date immunizations.

12th	6th grade immunizations (meningococcal is required at 12th grade entry, and Varicella not required but recommended) Sports Physical if participating in sports <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ <u>Must show proof of receiving two doses of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV4). The second dose of MCV4 must be > 16 years of age</u>○ <u>If the first dose of MCV4 was administered > 16 years of age, then only 1 dose is required.</u>
