1. Call to order, roll call, and verification:  
The Regular Meeting of the Rantoul Township High School District 193 Board of Education was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Ann Reale. Roll call was made. Doug Jordahl, present; Kelly Foster, present; Jeremy Larson, present; Jolene Pacunas, present; Ann Reale, present; Roger Quinlan, present; Janet Brotherton, present.
2. Pledge of Allegiance  
Everyone stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Action on the Consent Agenda:
  - a. Approval of tonight's agenda.
  - b. Approval of the regular meeting minutes held on September 11, 2017, and special board meeting minutes on September 18<sup>th</sup> and October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2017.
  - c. Approval of bills and payroll to be paid.
  - d. Approval of Amended Board Policy 6:210 – Instructional Materials  
President Reale asked if everyone had looked at the Consent Agenda and if there were any questions or changes. As there were no further questions, President Reale determined the Consent Agenda be approved. Jeremy Larson moved to approve the Consent Agenda. Seconded by Doug Jordahl. 4. Receiving and hearing of individual citizens and citizens' delegations: None
5. Freedom of Information Act Requests – (Two) Mr. Amerio explained that we have received two FOIA requests. 1) Request for a listing of our outside vendors. 2) Request for a listing of our outstanding debts and our superintendent's salary.
6. Reading Communications Received: Thank you notes from Ms. Elizabeth Carsley and also from Ms. Betty Jones.
7. Information Items:
  - a. September Student of the Month, Jared Motley, was unable to attend.
  - b. Special Education Team Presentation: Ms. Michelle Strater introduced the Special Education Teachers who were present. Each teacher along

with the student they had brought to the meeting, explained to the board what they were doing in their classrooms at this time. Mrs. Michelle Tatar, Ms. Brittani Miller, Mrs. Dede Graham, and Mrs. Welty-Peachy were all in attendance. Mrs. Tatar's student explained how she likes her classes and felt comfortable here at RTHS. Ms. Miller's students gave us a brief explanation of their "Self Esteem" Unit. Mrs. Graham's student explained how she had an anxiety disorder, and how her teacher was helping her overcome her disability. Mrs. Welty-Peachy students sang a song for us and demonstrated their rhythm sticks.

- c. Financial Update: Mr. Amerio gave a brief update regarding \$135,000.00 worth of missing mandated categorical payments. Mr. Amerio will also be attending a IASA sponsored meeting in Bloomington on October 18<sup>th</sup> regarding information on evidence-based funding.
- d. Administrator Reports: Each administrator had filed a report for the board to review: Attached. Mr. Wilson also spoke on how he was building a relationship between our parents and the teachers. Every two weeks the teachers have to turn in a listing of parents they have contacted either via email, phone or face to face. Parent Teacher Conferences will be held this week. Mr. Larson told Mr. Wilson that he was doing a great job, and that he was going above and beyond for our parents and staff.
- e. Board Repots: Advisory Board will meet later this month. Currently Mr. Amerio is working on a survey to give to the Sophomore Class regarding their perception of the high school compared to their experience during their freshman year.  
Mr. Amerio thanked Mrs. Brotherton and the board for providing pizza for the Administrators. It was much appreciated.  
Mr. Roger Quinlan had met with the Teacher Association and they were very complimentary of the Administration. It was a very positive meeting and the teachers said they felt supported by the Administrative Team.
- f. Property Tax Appeals Update: Mr. Amerio gave the board an update on the Twin Lakes and Golfview Tax Appeals. Both have moved to the State level, Mr. Amerio will continue to keep the board informed.

Motion to approve the personnel recommendations as presented. Motion made by Doug Jordahl, Seconded by Kelly Foster. Roll call vote: Jordahl, yes; Foster, yes; Larson, yes; Reale, yes; Pacunas, yes; Quinlan, yes; Brotherton, yes. Motion Carried.

c. Intergovernmental Agreement for Primary Police Services: The board was provided with a copy of the Intergovernmental agreement between RTHS and the Village of Rantoul for Police Services (SRO) to the high school.
