Rantoul Township High School receives federal funding each year to spend on improving the academic performance of our students. This funding is a provision of the Every Student Succeeds Act and is referred to as Title 1 and Title IIA funding. Teacher salaries are paid with grant funding to staff Strategic Literacy classes, Algebra and Geometry Labs, as well as intervention study hall teachers. This funding also benefits all students via the purchase of classroom supplies such as but not limited to school supplies, reference books, supplemental workbooks, and novels as well as technology equipment such as mobile laptop carts, Chromebook carts, an IPAD cart and interactive whiteboards. The district also uses these funds to support staff members by paying for high quality staff development for teachers.
