- Student achievement and timely graduation:

 - Interventions provided to students who are failing to meet standards
 - Instructional strategies for those students identified as failing to meet standards
 - Provide students with highly qualified staff and that students of all economic levels are instructed by experienced and well-trained teachers
 - Providing students with effective school library programming an digital resources
 - Resources for gifted and talented students
- College and career readiness:
 - Coordination with institutions of higher learning and access to dual credit programming
 - Career and technical education programming and coordination with our local EFE
- Professional development for staff
- Safe and healthy learning environment
 - Reduce incidences of bullying and harassment
 - Provide resources for homeless students
- Title 1 specific indicators:
 - Responsibilities for students identified as needing comprehensive or targeted support—RTHS does not qualify due to our commendable rating
