Letter to parents/guardians and athletes from Coach Dietz:

Eligibility for tryouts:

- 1. Prospective cheerleaders must meet IHSA academic requirements. (must be passing 3 of 4 classes)
- 2. Prospective cheerleaders must be willing to abide by the rules as listed in the RTHS Athletic Code of Conduct and those set in place by the IHSA and cheerleading coaches.

Note the following IHSA rules:

- 3.1.2- Jewelry of any kind is prohibited except for the following: A religious medal without a chain is allowed and must be taped and worn under the uniform. A medical-alert medal must be taped and can be visible.
- 2.1.4- Fingernails, including artificial nails, must be kept short, near the end of fingers.
- 3. Prospective cheerleaders must complete a permission form prior to participating in clinics.

What to expect on the day of tryouts:

Tryouts are closed to the public and are judged by coaches, teachers, and unaffiliated parties. There will be several clinic days to prepare and learn the material for tryouts. Don't stress if you are unable to attend a clinic day due to a conflict with another sport or school activity. You will be responsible for making up all the material, but videos and material will be posted on our Facebook page. If you are unable to attend the tryout day due to a conflict, you have the opportunity to schedule an alternative tryout date. All clinics and tryout dates will take place on the track/football field at RTHS. On the day of tryouts, athletes are encouraged to wear cheer shoes/tennis shoes, have their hair up and off of their face, and wear athletic clothes.

VARSITY CAMP: Ultimate Xperience Camp - Effingham

INFORMATION: The Ultimate Xperience Camp is a 3.5 day camp that is based around the IHSA cheerleading Rubric.

Day 1 will be a full day of skills instruction with top stunt technique coaches from around the United States. This day will build proper technique for your team from the ground up to prepare them for two days of high rubric range stunts.

Day 2 and 3 will provide customized instruction for your team. Your athletes will learn a high range IHSA stunt sequence, pyramid sequence, jump/tumbling sequence, & game day section. Each sequence taught gives you the opportunity to work with multiple instructors. We believe that exposure to multiple coaching styles and talents give each athlete the full camp experience.

The last day is competition day! Your athletes will compete all of the sequences they learned over the course of camp for prizes, with the chance to be our Ultimate Team! Competition day is also a chance for your individual athletes to compete for prizes with one athlete being named the ultimate athlete. Seniors will have a shot at our \$500.00 Senior Scholarship and opportunities to be recruited by collegiate programs. Each athlete will receive a camp TSHIRT.
